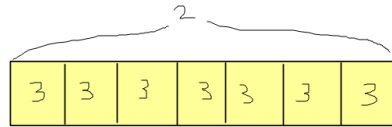

$$\frac{2}{7} \text{ of } 21 = 6$$

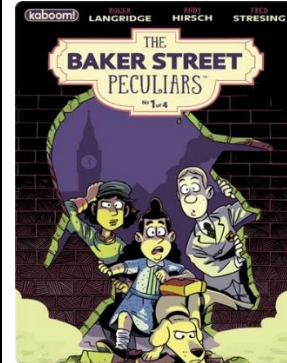


$$21 \div 7 = 3 \quad \frac{2}{7} = 6$$

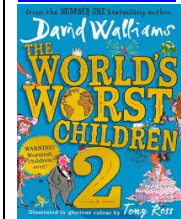
