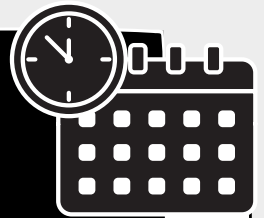
## UNIFORM AT MARLCLIFFE
