

Medication

- Pupils with asthma must bring 2 inhalers.

 - One will be carried by the pupil at all times
- All medications must be labelled clearly with the child's name and the dose to be administered.
- On the Tuesday morning, all medication must be given to Miss Pepler, with appropriate paperwork. If possible, please try to bring them in the Monday (4th November), we know this may not be possible but it would be easier than them all arriving on Tuesday!
