I have had the pleasure of holding several more Hot Chocolate with the Head events since the last edition of the Marlcliffe Mail. The following children have attended recently:

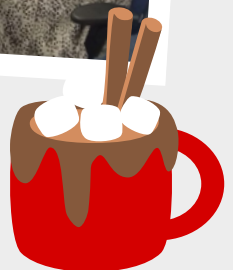

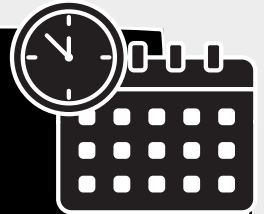

WOW WALK TO SCHOOL CHALLENGE

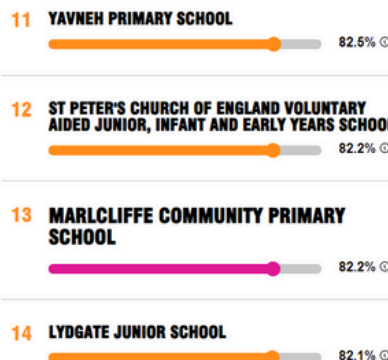

SCHOOL LEADERBOARD

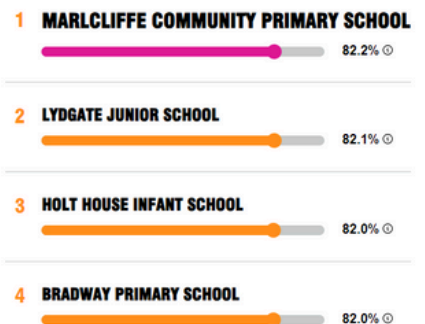
BY COUNTRY

START SMALL, DREAM BIG!



We are delighted that as a school we have been selected to take part in a project being run across schools nationally. The project is called Start Small, Dream Big and is about looking at developing Careers Related Learning in primary schools. Start Small, Dream Big is a national programme funded by the Careers & Enterprise Company (CEC) and backed by the Department for Education (DfE), which is being delivered through CEC's Careers Hub network. The programme holds huge importance for the future of careers education. It gives schools the opportunity to be part of an innovative national programme of activity and research, influencing and shaping future policy decisions on primary career-related learning. Through participation in this programme, career-related learning and skills development will become embedded into our curriculum teaching, leading to an enhanced curriculum that will impact the learning outcomes for all. In particular, here at Maricliffe, we want to broaden our children's awareness of the world of work and raise aspirations as well as challenge some gender stereotypes in relation to the world of work. As part of this project, we plan to create a directory of parents who are willing to talk to the children about their career. Look out for more information coming home about the project. Mrs Fallon (Y4) is leading this project for the school.



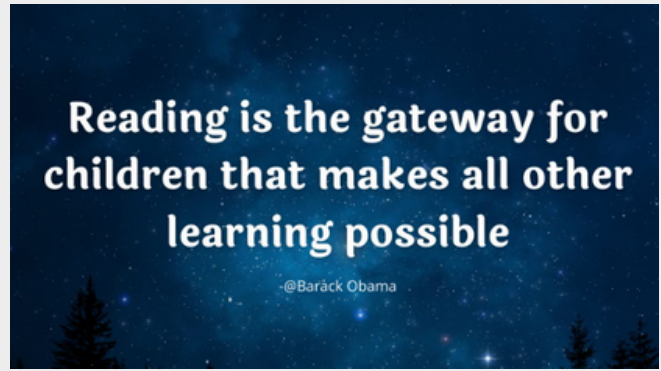
